REVIEW OF BCGK, INC. INTER-MUNICIPAL LIQUOR LICENSE TRANSFER REQUEST

Review of the BCGK, Inc. request regarding the inter-municipal transfer of a Pennsylvania "R" or "restaurant" liquor license from outside the municipality into the Borough of Bridgeville. The property location is 820 McLaughlin Run Road and is currently vacant. A Public Hearing Notice outlining this request has been duly advertised in the March 24 and April 4, 2011 editions of the Tribune Review per the requirements of the Liquor Code (47 P.S. Section 102).

CITIZEN COMMENTS

Michele A. Owens – 820 McLaughlin Run Road

Michele Owens stated that she is the individual leasing the restaurant and applying for the liquor license transfer at 820 McLaughlin Run Road. She stated that she is opening a family oriented restaurant that will also serve liquor. She noted that she ran Mariani's Restaurant in South Fayette for 10 years, giving her the experience needed. There will be no entertainment at

this time and she will be the working manager and the cook. M. Weise questioned the availability of parking. She noted that approximately 35 spaces are available at the rear of the building. She stated that she plans on having all of her employees and herself certified and up to date with the LCB regulations and Allegheny County Health certifications. She stated that the name of the restaurant is going to be "Shelby Station" and the opening date will be in approximately 8 weeks.

Manager Collins stated that the Building Inspector has been working with the property owner and they have completed all of their inspections. A Certificate of Occupancy will be needed prior to the opening of the restaurant.
